WELCOME TO SUNSET BEACH



We strive to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all our residents and guests. We hope this informational pamphlet will help answer any questions so that you have the safest experience here in our town. Enjoy your time with us!

Things to remember ...

- Always keep the doors to your residence/vehicles locked and secured. Remove all valuables from your vehicle.
- The legal drinking age is 21 years old. Do not consume alcohol if you are under the legal drinking age. Consume alcohol responsibly and always have a designated driver.
- Follow all traffic laws; such as remaining buckled in your seat and obeying posted speeds/road signs.
- If you come across any lost items, please bring them to the Sunset Beach Police Department. We log them in our computer system and hold them until claimed.
- Please clean up after yourself and do not leave litter. We want our town to remain as beautiful as possible.
- If you're unsure about any of our ordinances, feel free to call and ask or flag down one of our officers when you see them around town.

PARKING

We would like to take a moment to share some tips for visiting our wonderful community without incurring unnecessary fines. Aside from our public lots, visitors can park along the right of way, unless otherwise posted.

Things to remember ...

- Tires completely off pavement. This will keep you from obstructing the bike path.
- Parallel parking only. Make sure your vehicle is facing the same direction of travel.
- No double parallel parking. We want a nice, single line of cars on either side of the street.
- Do not block driveways, obstruct sidewalks and/or beach accesses, or fire hydrants.
- No parking on side streets or other areas where the signs indicate not to.

BEACH RULES

- No cabanas, shading devices, or similar items may be placed within a 30ft wide path (15ft on either side) from the end of any town emergency access road or public beach access walkway.
- No cabanas, shading devices, or similar items can be placed between 3rd Street and 29th Street.
- Cabanas and shading devices shall not exceed 12'x12' and anchor tie-downs should be installed as manufacturer requires. There must be a 10ft space between tents. Rear of structure or anchor points can not extend beyond the trash can line into the emergency access lane.
- No cabanas, shading devices or similar items can be erected prior to 7:00am, and must be removed by 7:00pm.
- Stay off the dunes and only use public access walkways.

- No glass containers on the beach.
- No camping and/or open fires on the beach. No grills of any kind.
- No surfing or net fishing in the Atlantic Ocean between 5th street and 32nd street May 1st through October 31st.
- No digging holes on the beach strand larger than 18in deep and 5 ft wide. Holes must be attended at all times and filled back in before leaving the beach strand but no later than 7pm, whichever occurs first.
- The safety of anyone in your party is your responsibility. Please be vigilant while swimming. If you see someone in distress CALL 911 immediately.

LOW SPEED VEHICLES

- At no time are golf carts and/or electric, battery operated vehicles allowed on the beach strand .. this includes all E-Bikes Onewheels and/or Hoverboards.
- Golf cart drivers must be at least 16yrs old and hold a valid driver's license. Registered golf carts can be driven legally on the roadway (not the sidewalk) anywhere the posted speed is 35mph or less.
- All occupants must use seatbelts. Young children must be in car and/or booster seats if applicable.
- Golf carts must be inspected and registered in North Carolina or by a state that has identical standards as North Carolina.
- Golf carts must have the following equipment to comply with state law: head lamps, parking brakes, rearview mirrors, reflectors, seat belts, speedometer, stop lamps, tail lamps, turn signal lamps, VIN, windshield, and windshield wipers.

ANIMALS

- Pets must be on leashes, no longer than 10ft, at all times. Please pick up after your pet.
- Pets are not permitted on the beach strand from 9am to 6pm the Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- It is not uncommon to see a fox, raccoon, opossum, or other wild animals here at Sunset Beach. It is unlawful to feed wild animals and feral cats. Please call if you feel threatened by a wild animal or they are showing signs of illness.
- Do not feed the alligators, they are very dangerous. If you see someone feeding or otherwise tampering with an alligator, CALL 911 immediately.

NO FIREWORKS

 No fireworks of any kind are allowed per Sunset Beach Town Ordinance.
 Violations are subject to a \$100 fine.
